

CARE Report

CARE Project for the next two years is called Educational Opportunities for Girls. The expected results of the project are as follows. 1) An increase in the number of secondary school girls who remain in school and complete all grades, and a related reduction in teen pregnancies. 2) An improvement in the self-confidence, social abilities, leadership skills and life plans of secondary school girls. 3) An increased awareness and active commitment to the education of girls among parents, teachers and principals from secondary schools.

Our goal for this year is \$40,000 and we currently have \$28346 which is a BIG increase since our last COG meeting. **THANK YOU.** We have 1 month left in the year to accomplish our goal. At this time I am encouraging District Governors to contact your CARE Reps and Zone Chairs to promote a donation to CARE one last time. If clubs have already donated and have remaining funds at year end encourage an additional donation. Ask each member to donate \$5.00 because they are proud to be a Lion.
